



PRE-ASMIRT 2022 HEALTH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Prior to attending ASMIRT 2022 today, please read the conditions below carefully and confirm that you meet the following health requirements as a condition of entry to ASMIRT 2022.

- ✓ **I am not currently experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19**
- ✓ **If I have experienced symptoms, I have done a RAT test and it has come up negative**
- ✓ **I am not currently required to isolate for any reason**
- ✓ **I comply with ASMIRT2022 entry requirements (including showing my proof of vaccination) and a temperature test on arrival to the venue.**

ASMIRT 2022 COVID COMPLIANCE

All attendees at ASMIRT 2022 are required to be vaccinated. Please show your proof of vaccination upon arrival at the venue. You will only be required to show this once, and your name tag will be used as proof of vaccination after entry.

All attendees must scan into the event using the ASMIRT 2022 Registration Check-in QR Code. Attendees must scan in each day they attend. If you do not have a smart phone, please go to the registration desk and the staff will sign you in.

Temperature testing will be conducted on your arrival at the venue every time. If the temperature reading is over 37.5 degrees, you will be asked to go into an air-conditioned room for five (5) minutes, and your temperature will be retested. If it remains too high, you will be asked to leave the venue and do a RAT test. If this comes back negative you can come back in the venue, but we encourage you to wear a mask.

All ASMIRT 2022 attendees are expected to sanitise / wash their hands regularly throughout the event. Sanitiser will be available throughout the venue, at registration, and in the exhibition hall.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Social distancing throughout the conference is everyone's responsibility. To enjoy networking in person, please remember to follow the coloured lanyard social distancing preferences.

Green lanyard – handshake.

You are comfortable with shaking hands with fellow attendees.

Yellow lanyard – elbow bump.

You are not quite up for a handshake, but an elbow bump will be fine.

Red lanyard – wave.

It's nice to see you, but let's keep our distance.

We have hired out all the large rooms in the conference venue to enable social distancing. Where possible we recommend seating in the same seat.

MASKS

Masks are available at the Registration Desk if you'd like one. We also strongly recommend the use of masks where it is difficult to social distance.
